The Election Collection introduces early elementary learners to foundational civic concepts and vocabulary words that will help them process what they are already observing all around them this election season, and lay the groundwork for them to become active and engaged citizens as they mature.

Young children are observant – during this election season they are picking up bits of information from their families, their neighbors, the news, and advertisements. And by nature, they are trying to make sense of it all.

From fundamental concepts like DEMOCRACY and CITIZEN, to civic actions like VOTE, to the necessary social skills that help a democracy function like CONVERSATION and COMPROMISE, this collection of election videos offers an age-appropriate introduction to important new words.

CIVIC VALUES

Important during an election year, but also tenants of quality character education, OOPA explores various civic values in The Election Collection:

- Everyone deserves respect
- Everyone has something to share with their voice
- Contributing to your community and supporting community members is important
- With leadership comes responsibility
- Speaking and listening are both essential parts of a healthy conversation

VIDEO FORMAT

Like all videos in OOPA'S World of Words, these election videos uniquely combine language and literacy skills, physical movement, and emotional reflection. When new words are experienced through multiple modalities, including movement, we increase accessibility to substantive learning and solidify greater retention.

In each 5-minute video, Oopa explores a new word-of-the-day through:

- a playful scenario with a guest visitor that illustrates the meaning of the word
- an interactive movement segment that helps children make a physical connection to the word
- a closing reflection on an emotional connection to the word
